History



2002

Joe and Mary purchase Cohn Vineyard west of Healdsburg. The vineyard was first planted in 1970.

2005

Joe and Mary partner with Mike to found Benovia Winery at Martaella Vineyard and begin production.

2008

Benovia Winery purchases land adjacent to the winery and plans vineyard expansion and new winery.

2009

The winery plants a third vineyard, Tilton Hill, in the Sonoma Coast AVA.

2015

Construction on the new winery facility is completed as well as the Ranch House Tasting Room is opened for tastings.


Vineyard Practices

- Embracing small vine viticulture, our vineyards are planted at very high density, to encourage low per vine yields and the highest level of quality
- We utilize precision viticultural techniques
- Working with Mark Greenspan (Advanced Viticultural Consulting) to apply the latest technology in the vineyard.
- The Benovia team has planted 10 heirloom Pinot Noir clones and 6 Chardonnay clones which each bring different characteristics to the wine – and each clone reacts differently to the weather and growing season of each vintage



Winemaking Philosophy

- Small lot fermentation, minimum intervention
- Grapes are harvested at night to maximize freshness
- Cluster and berry sorted, to assure the highest quality
- Hand and Pneumatic Punchdown of Pinot Noir
- Benovia is at the forefront of innovative winemaking techniques and technology with a sleek winemaking facility that was christened with the 2015 vintage, yet the team still relies on artisanal practices such as meticulously hand sorting the fruit during harvest
- Old world care meets new world technology in the expanded winery, which gives us more flexibility during fermentation and the time and space to be responsive to each wine's individual needs





Bottling & Aging



Bottling

- Own our own bottling line
 - Vertical integration is important for quality control
 - Allows us to bottle each wine when it is ready and not just a date on a calendar

Barrel Program

- Working with small, family-owned cooperages in Burgundy - Rousseau, Cavin, Francois Freres
- Tight grained, slow toasting for maximum site expression
